ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be held in the Sports Hall on Friday, 11 November 2016.

All teams that are arriving on Friday must come to the accreditation before going to their hotel.

ENTRY FEE

Entry fee for U14 and U16:	12 € per athlete per start
Entry fee for U18 (cadets):	15 € per athlete

WEIGH-IN

Official weigh-in will be held on the day of the competition according to the programme. Each athlete must present their passport or identity card.

DRAW

A computerised draw will be held on the day of the competition according to the programme. If a team has 3 or more competitors in one weight category, the coach may come to the main desk prior to the draw and assign the two seeded players who will then be put on the opposite sides of the draw table.

JUDO GI CONTROL

All athletes must have a judogi of correct size. The referees will check the size before each fight.

The first called athlete shall wear a white judogi. The second called athlete may wear a blue judogi or a white judogi together with a red belt provided by the organiser.

COMPETITION RULES

COMPETITION AREA

The competition will take place on 6 contest areas—6 m by 6 m with 3 m safety area.

COMPETITION SYSTEM

A standard knock-out system with double repechage (losers to the semi-finalists get to fight again). In a category with 5 competitors or less, a round-robin system will be used. In case of 2 competitors in a category, the best-of-three system will be used.

REFEREEING RULES

The competition will be conducted according to the latest IJF refereeing rules. Additional rules for U14 and U16:

U14: **NO SHIME-WAZA, NO KANSETSU-WAZA**

U16: **NO SHIME-WAZA**

SCORING

5 athletes or less: 5, 3, 1 (points awarded to the first three)

More than 5 athletes: 10, 7, 5, 5, 3, 3, 1, 1 (points awarded to the first 7)

AWARDING CEREMONY

The awarding ceremony for each age group will take place directly after the last fights in that group.

All athletes must come to the medal podium wearing a white judogi.

MEDALS AND PRIZES

The first three athletes in each category will receive medals and practical awards.

The best male and female judoka in each age category will receive trophies.

The best five teams will receive trophies.

The winners (1st place) in each category of the cadets (U18) competition will receive 50 € in prize money.

LIVE STREAM

Live stream of the entire event will be available at www.judo-koroska.com/live. It will be possible to choose between different cameras (tatamis). There will also be a live order of the upcoming matches.

TEAM EVENT FOR CADETS

On Sunday, 13 November, after the individual competition U16, the 3rd Turpal-Ali Kadyrov memorial with prize money in total of 7.000 € will be held.

The competition will be organised by our club together with Judo club Edelweiss from Grozny, Russia in memory of Turpal-Ali Kadyrov.

REGISTRATION OF TEAMS

Please specify in the entry form which athletes will compete in the team event. If you do not have a whole team, you can still enter individual athletes who will then be combined with other teams.

Teams can register until 12.00 on the day of the competition. The coaches must provide a list of all the team members.

ENTRY FEE

Boys: 130 € per team

Girls: 60 € per team

WEIGH-IN

Official weigh-in will be held on the day of the competition according to the programme.

All athletes who participated in the U16 individual event will not be required to come to the weigh-in.

All athletes who participated in the U18 individual event the previous day will be allowed a 5 % tolerance.

DURATION OF CONTESTS

3 minutes

COMPETITION MODE

The participating teams will be split into groups of 4 teams where they will compete with each other in a round-robin system. The best 2 teams from each group will advance to the quarter-final.

The advancing teams will then compete in a standard knock-out system without repechage. The losers in the semi-finals will fight for third place.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- a team may consist of up to 8 athletes;
- each athlete may compete in his own weight category or the next higher category;
- all athletes in a team must wear a judogi of the same colour (all white or all blue).

REFEREEING RULES

The competition will be conducted according to the latest IJF refereeing rules.

AWARDING CEREMONY

The awarding ceremony will take place after the final contest has been finished.

All athletes must come to the medal podium wearing a judogi.

MEDALS AND PRIZES (IN TOTAL OF 7.000 €)

BOYS

First place: Gold medals for all team members and 2.500 €

Second place: Silver medals for all team members and 1.500 €

Third place: Bronze medals for all team members and 1.000 €

GIRLS

First place: Gold medals for all team members and 1.000 €

Second place: Silver medals for all team members and 600 €

Third place: Bronze medals for all team members and 400 €
